EDITORIAL REQUIREMENTS

Length of the article up to 6 pages.

The text of the article in the English language, the format MS Word, the font Times New Roman (12 points), the space between lines: 1,5. A standard page of format A4, the margins: left: 3,5 cm, other: 2,5 cm.

Structure of the article

- title - 14 points, capital letters, thickened, centered,
- Author's name and surname - 12 points, italics, centered,
- name of the institution – 12 points, italics, centered,
- introduction, key words (3-4 words),
- text - 12 points, space between lines 1,5, with line indentation 6 mm at the beginning of each paragraph, justified,
- notes directly in the text in the format [No., p.24] - where No. means a number of position in the bibliography list,
- bibliography - 11 points, in the format: [number] surname and name of the author, title (in italics), publishing house, place of publishing, year.
- abstract - 11 points, italics, in the Polish or Russian language.

Dear Sir or Madam

You are cordially invited to participate in an international students' summer camp organized under the idea: 'Young people in integrating Europe' by the College of Economy, Tourism and Social Sciences in Kielce.

This meeting will be held in the period of 12 - 19.07.2010 in Kielce. About 60 students from 10 - 12 European countries will take part in the camp. Due to the limited number of places for each school, 3-4 participants (including a tutor) can take part in it. The participation in the camp is free of charge, participants only cover the cost of travel. Because of the diversity of languages, we would like to ask you to single out students who speak English at least communicatively.

The aim and program of the camp are very extensive. In their scope they will cover a broad spectrum of problems connected with European integration on the planes: cultural, social, political and economic. Therefore, we plan to organize a wide range of events having different content and form:

- international scientific conference,
- evening of cultures, during which students will present the history, customs, cultures of regions and countries they come from,
- lectures conducted by experts on the issues of European integration (lecturers, politicians, MEPs),
- integrating workshops and meetings.

A detailed program of the camp is presented in the attachment.

The result of the meeting will be acquainting students with the issues of contemporary Europe, indicating the possibility of young people's involvement in the integration processes, indicating planes for building good neighborly relationships and overcoming barriers and mutual prejudices in neighborly relationships.

We plan to publish the articles presented during the conference in an electronic version (CD) before the start of the camp. While later we will publish an extensive study which will include post-conference materials, lectures, findings and proposals for further actions.

We cordially invite you to take part in the project on a scale of young people of the 21st century!!!
